#### THE FIRST AEARU MEDICAL CENTER WORKSHOP

April 21-23, Shenzhen, China

With the support of the AEARU Board, the once planned for April 2003 and then postponed on account of the out-break of Atypical Pneumonia, also known as Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS), in this part of the world, the Workshop was rescheduled for April 21-23, 2004 in Shenzhen, China.

This Workshop was organized by Peking University, Taiwan University, and Hong Kong University of Science and technology and was sponsored by Shenzhen PKU-HKUST Medical Center and HKUST. The theme of the Workshop was to raise the awareness of "the Synergy of Biomedical Research and Clinical Application in the Development of a 21st Century Medical Center".
