## 28th Annual General Meeting Minutes

## I. Introductory Remarks

#### 1. Welcome Remarks

Professor Xinhe BAO (USTC), AEARU Chairperson and USTC president, welcomed the delegates for participating in the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting. Professor BAO introduced USTC delegates, Professor Kun QU, the meeting moderator and the Director of the Office of International Cooperation, and Professor Yifu CAI, the Deputy Director of the Office of International Cooperation. He also thanked all the members for helping USTC with so many things this year. Lastly, he confirmed that all the members were present, so the meeting was effective.

#### 2. Announcement of Recent Change in Presidency of Member Universities

Professor QU informed attendees that there was a change of presidency at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology: President Wei Shyy to President Nancy Yuk-Yu IP (October 2022). Ms. Yvonne LI (HKUST) gave BOD members a brief introduction about President IP.

#### 3. Announcement of the University of Tsukuba's withdrawal from AEARU

Professor QU announced the University of Tsukuba on their retreat, effective on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Professor BAO and QU expressed their regret towards this decision and paid tribute to all the members for their efforts and contributions.

#### **II.** Confirmation of The Minutes

The University of Tokyo virtually hosted the 27<sup>th</sup> AGM on November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The electronic copy has been sent in advance, and the final version will be available on the AEARU website (aearu.com). Professor QU mentioned that several minutes would be allocated to review pages 7 to 12 of this meeting minutes.

Since there were no further comments from the members, Professor BAO concluded that members confirmed the 27<sup>th</sup> AGM meeting minutes.

#### III. Treasury Report

Professor QU acknowledged the receipt of a surplus of \$98,138.84 from the last Secretariat. At this writing, the Secretariat has received members fees from all members.

The current sum totals \$134,112.90.

## IV. Review of activities after April 20th 2022 (27th AGM)

#### 1. The AEARU Future Scientist Exchange Program by the USTC

Professor QU briefed the BOD members on the outcome of this online program, named Future Scientist Exchange Program (FuSEP) Summer Camp at USTC from June 27<sup>th</sup> 2022 to July 8<sup>th</sup> 2022, and invited the BOD members to review the Activity & Financial Report furnished by USTC. All the BOD members gave the green light to subsidize USTC for this event with 6,000 US Dollars.

#### 2. Global Learning Initiatives Program

Professor QU updated the BOD members on the Global Learning Initiatives Program (GLIP) by quoting the data from the Fall semester 2022 -- six member universities offered 27 courses with 30 applicants (17 were admitted). AEARU will support these six universities financially and the same policy for the previous applies.

Professor QU also announced that the spring application of next year would continue. Course information would be called for from members in coming December. The Secretariat would contact all members once the schedule is confirmed. Professor QU announced the final funding amount for the spring and fall semesters and would issue the payment accordingly.

## V. Scheduled AEARU Activities after November 29th 2022 (28th AGM)

Ms. Yvonne LI (HKUST) presented the BOD members with the Summer Institute of Extended Flipped Education program, which will be held at HKUST this summer by detailing the format of the program (The uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic was considered), the targeted participants, the project content, etc..

#### VI. Other Issues

Professor QU proposed to waive the \$2,000 annual fee for all members in 2023 because there was less financial expenditure on offline activities during the COVID-19 pandemic. The proposal was discussed at the BOD meeting and was concurred on by the BOD members. Since there were no further comments from the members, Professor BAO concluded that there would be no need to have 2,000 USD from each member university next year. Meanwhile, this proposal aims to reduce the financial burden on member universities, and the exemption of fees for one year will hardly impact the association's future development.

Professor BAO announced that at the 51<sup>st</sup> BOD meeting, the Boards had voted to elect the Vice-Chairperson of AEARU for 2023, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and expressed congratulations. On behalf of HKUST, Ms. Yvonne LI thanked other member universities for their support and was honoured to accept the appointment.

During the 50th BOD meeting on April 20th, Ms. Yvonne Li (HKUST) suggested alternating the BOD meetings between online and offline formats in the following years. Professor Qu mentioned that this topic was to be discussed at the 2022 AGM when all member universities would be present. In the 2022 AGM, Professor Qu inquired about comments from members, and they concurred that the BOD meeting for Spring would be held virtually. Additionally, Professor QU also mentioned that USTC will host the 52<sup>nd</sup> BOD Meeting. Ms. Yvonne LI (HKUST) stated that HKUST would host 53<sup>rd</sup> BOD meeting and 29<sup>th</sup> AGM for the Fall session and welcomed member universities to Hong Kong to attend an in-person meeting.

Professor BAO recommended the University of Macau (UM) to join AEARU. He also reminded attendees that according to the constitution of AEARU, the total number of members is twenty, and we currently have only eighteen members. Moreover, the participation of UM was conducive to facilitating the long-term development of AEARU, expanding the influence of AEARU and promoting pluralistic cooperation among member universities.

All of the member universities expressed support for the admission of UM.

#### VII. Adjournment

Closing Remarks by Professor BAO. He thanked all attending delegates for joining the meeting today and expressed his appreciation for being the AEARU Chairperson and

would continue to be of service. He also looked forward to collaborating with all member universities in the future.
